As a worksite, you have the opportunity to directly impact the lives of young Latinxs so they learn the skills necessary to secure stable and enriching careers for the future.

Benefits to being a Worksite

Increased productivity; expansion of generational team perspectives, an opportunity to invest in the future workforce of Allegheny County and the City of Pittsburgh.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 Provide one Latinx supervisor who directly oversee employed youth.
- 2 Supervisors need PA criminal background check, PA Child abuse, FBI fingerprint clearances. (As clearances often take an extended period of time to process, we urge all worksites to seek out these clearances as early as possible).
- 3 Proof of organization or business is more than 2 years old.
